Joliet Area Historical Museum

One of the many exhibits consists of a reproduction of one of the hallmark limestone turrets that create the façade of the architecturally significant prison. **Joliet Prison**, photographs of the inside of the prison and a variety of Blues Brothers novelties.

Old Joliet Prison Park

Once you arrive, a HUGE steel and barbed wire entry sign will beckon you in to a park unlike any other. Your group will be greeted by a guide who will share his knowledge of the prison. Eight informational kiosks offer an insight into historical information regarding the inmate's history, building architecture and the timeline of reformation and tragedy at the prison are all represented with vivid photographs to illustrate the concepts. Kiosks also detail the prison's film history from Blues Brothers to Prison Break and so much more! Guests are reminded to bring their fedora for a great photo opportunity.
