Miami

Costa Maya

Not Included: Increases in security fees, taxes and fuel surcharges. Documentation: A valid passport is required. Passports must be valid for a minimum of 6 months from return date. Names on reservation for air and cruise must match your passport.

Air Schedule & Seat Assignments: Air fare is estimated at \$400 at this time and is subject to change. Seat requests cannot be guaranteed. The airlines, now more than ever, block many rows of seats to be assigned at check-in only, providing those with less desirable seats the possibility of changing their seat assignments upon check-in.

Cancellation Policy: If you must cancel, the following per person penalties apply. Without exception, all cancellations must be in writing to Viking Travel Service and are effective the date of receipt. Any unused portions of the cruise/tour are non-refundable. No shows or no written notice will result in 100% penalty.
