Springfield, Illinois Overnight A Journey Through Illinois History

October 20 – 21, 2010

Day 1 Departure / Springfield

Early morning departure with a rest stop along the way.

Arrive Springfield and enjoy a tour of:

Lincoln's Tomb- The 117-foot tall granite tomb contains the bodies of Lincoln, his wife Mary, and three of his four sons. The tomb attracts visitors from all over the world.

Illinois State Capital-Lincoln spent much of his time in the building, where he tried cases before the Illinois Supreme Court, borrowed books from the state library, and swapped stories with other lawyers and politicians. He delivered his famous "House Divided" speech.

Lincoln's Home-Beautifully restored to its 1860 appearance, the Greek Revival house was Abraham and Mary Lincoln's home for 17 years. In 1844 they bought it for \$1,200 and some land from the Rev. Charles Dresser, who performed their marriage ceremony in 1842.

Day 2 Springfield / Return

Continental breakfast this morning followed by check-out. We then begin our day of touring with a stop at:

Dana-Thomas House—designed in 1902 by Frank Lloyd Wright and now is the finest example of the creativity and uniqueness of the Prairie School of Architecture.

Vachel Lindsay House—Lifetime home of the native Springfield poet/artist. Built in the late 1840s and originally owned by Mr. and Mrs. Clark Smith, Mary Lincoln Todd's sister and brother-in-law.

This afternoon we visit the **Abraham Lincoln Presidential Museum**. The new facility will present Lincoln as he has never been presented before, using the latest interactive technology, film drama. Lunch will be on your own at the Museum.
